CALLING ALL TROUT FISHERMEN!

Carpenter's Brook Fish Hatchery is registering volunteers to help stock fish in area streams, lakes and ponds. Onondaga County waterways are scheduled to receive an estimated 70,000 trout from late March to mid-May. Volunteers are needed to help stock from March 24th through May 22nd, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Interested individuals can sign up by contacting the Fish Hatchery at (315) 689-9367 from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Volunteers need to be 18 years of age or older, able to lift 50 lbs and dressed for the weather, rain or shine. Volunteers need to commit for the entire day.

Carpenter's Brook Fish Hatchery, an Onondaga County Park facility, is open from 8:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. during the summer and is located on Route 321, 2.3 miles south of the Route 5 intersection in the Town of Elbridge. For more information on the Hatchery, call (315) 689-9367.
