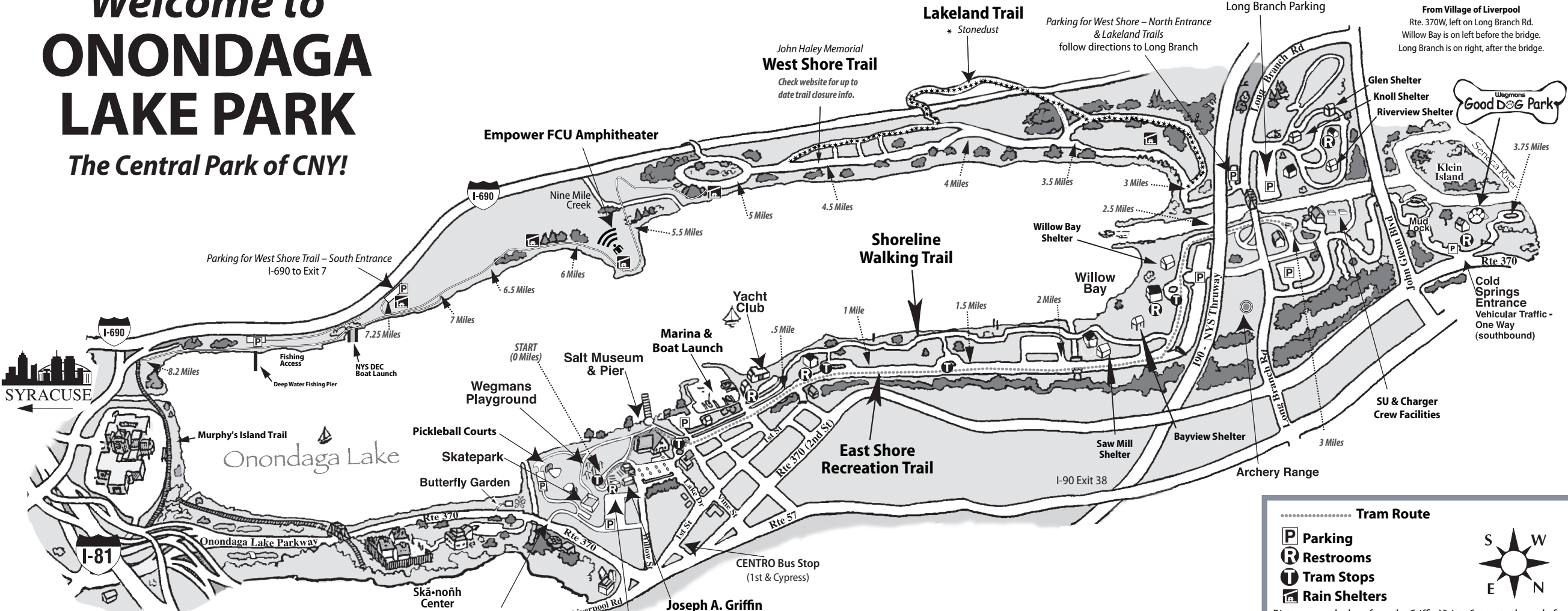

Directions to Long Branch & Willow Bay

From NYS Thruway (I90)
Exit 39 to I-690E to Exit 4. Right at 1st traffic light onto Long Branch Rd. Long Branch is on left before bridge. Willow Bay is on right, after the bridge.

From Village of Liverpool
Rte. 370W, left on Long Branch Rd. Willow Bay is on left before the bridge. Long Branch is on right, after the bridge.

General Trail Rules

- No motorized vehicles allowed
 - Maintain safe, controllable speed
 - Announce "passing" or "on your left" when passing
 - Wear proper safety equipment.
 - Be courteous to other users
 - Keep to the right
 - Report all accidents to Park staff
- Onondaga County law requires helmet use for ages 17 & under on bikes and inline skates.

Tram Hours

Monday - Friday 9 a.m. to 12 noon.
Monday after Mother's Day to Friday before Columbus Day - except holidays.
Weather Permitting.

East Shore Recreation Trail

Peak Season: April-October
Primary use is for wheeled users. Pedestrian use is allowed only if it does not impede wheeled users. No more than two abreast and stay within three feet of shoulder. No dogs allowed. Trams follow the center line.

Off Season: November-March
Wheels and pedestrians share the trail. Dogs on six foot leashes are allowed with pedestrians but not with wheeled users. No motorized vehicles allowed.

Shoreline Walking Trail

This trail is for "ON FOOT" activity and special uses. No wheels are allowed except for wheelchairs, strollers, tricycles and training wheels. Dogs must be on a six-foot leash. This trail is not plowed in the winter. Please use the East Shore Recreation Trail when it snows.
