

Make a Beaver Bank!

Materials

- Two milk jugs
- Paint / Brushes
- Scissors (and/or knife)
- Pencil / Sharpie
- Glue gun / (and/or tape)
- Stiff white paper

Directions

- 1.) Draw stencils for feet, tail, and teeth on paper and cut out. (Size of each should fit on jug panel they will be cut out of)
- 2.) Mark out panels to be cut out.
 - a. Area around handle: Teeth
 - b. Two big front panels: Rear legs
 - c. Area below handle: Front legs
 - d. Bottom: Tail
- 3.) Cut out panels trace stencils with sharpie.
- 4.) Cut out body parts. Paint them as well as other jug. (You'll need an extra cap for the nose: paint it black.)
- 5.) Assemble (Put coin slot in top first.)
 - a. Tail and rear feet can be taped or glued to bottom.
 - b. Front legs best if glued on.
 - c. Teeth (ring) fits around opening.
Screw on 'nose' cap.
 - d. Glue on eyes.
- 6.) Start saving money in your new bank!
