

Recycled Bird Feeder

Empty half gallon container

Scissors

Acrylic paints

Paintbrush(es)

Paint containers

Glue or duct tape

Sticks

At least 18 inches of sturdy twine, string or wire

1. Cut out a rectangle the entire width and about 3 1/2" high from the front of your carton, and then cut out the same size rectangle on the opposite side.
2. Cut out the plastic spout, or keep it on and add it to your design (think a chimney on a house)
3. Take the cut-out pieces and cut them into three 1" strips and one 1/2" strip. These will be the roof of the bird feeder.
4. Paint the panels and the container your desired color. Feel free to decorate it however you'd like.
5. Once the paint is dry, poke through 4 holes under the opening on the sides. This is where your sticks will go through.
6. Space them so they are staggered.
7. Glue down the panels onto the top of the container.
8. Then poke a hole through the top flap and string the twine or wire through it.
9. Fill with bird seed and then hang it up!
