This permit allows the bearer to use a metal detector in Onondaga County Parks with the following conditions:

- You are granted permission to enter only those areas normally open for public use and during regular open hours.
- Metal detecting is NOT permitted in the beach areas (when the beach is open); public reserved areas (when in use); athletic/ball fields; playgrounds; campgrounds; service areas used only by park personnel and during special events. At Onondaga Lake Park, metal detectors are not to be used in the Griffin Visitor Center, in the gated footprint of the Lakeview Amphitheater or any location along the West Shore Trail from the Thruway bridge to Harbor Brook. In addition, metal detecting is NOT permitted at Beaver Lake Nature Center, Hopkins Road Park, NBT Bank Stadium, Rosamond Gifford Zoo or at the Cemeteries.
- Each park contains sensitive underground facilities and infrastructure. Do not dig above, on or around marked underground facilities.
- Removal of detected objects must be confined to small items such as coins which can be removed with the point of a knife or other similar tool.
- Replace/repair any turf damage.
- All applicants are required to go to a park office to show their ID to validate this permit. For Pratt's Falls & during the non-beach season at Jamesville Beach, go to Highland Forest. For Oneida Shores Park during the winter months go to Onondaga Lake Park.
- You must have this permit on your person when using this device to show any Park Ranger or Park employee.

 Permit valid for one calendar year and must be renewed annually.
